

THE GAA NATIONAL CLUB DRAW 2026 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The promoter of this draw is Tom Ryan, Árd Stiúrthóir of the Gaelic Athletic Association (“GAA”), c/o Páirc an Chrócaigh, Dublin 3.
2. The draw is being held pursuant to a lottery licence granted by the Dublin Metropolitan District Court under S.28 of the Gaming and Lotteries Act 1956.
3. The object of the draw is to raise funds for the promotion of the GAA at club level.
4. This draw will take place on Wednesday 25th March 2026. The GAA reserves the right to postpone the draw for whatever reason for a period of up to six months. The draw will be conducted under the supervision of independent auditors. The decision in respect of prize winners shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
5. Winners will be notified directly by the GAA via the contact details provided on the ticket entry. The GAA shall not bear any responsibility in relation to incorrect contact details provided by any entrant.
6. For the purpose of ensuring full transparency of the National Club Draw, names of winners will be announced on the official GAA website. The winner agrees to the use of his/her name to be published in this manner.
7. No employees or members of the management committee of the GAA (or their immediate families) shall be permitted to participate in this draw.
8. The GAA reserves the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent or greater value without giving notice.
9. First prize in this year’s draw is a Toyota Corolla Hybrid. The colour and specifications of the vehicle may vary. Images are for illustrative purposes only and may not reflect the actual prize.
10. The GAA reserves the right to cancel or amend the terms and conditions of this draw at any time for any reason without notice.
11. No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered.
